UK Record Status + Rose Award

Burntwood York for Visually Impaired

Junior awards for Bristol rounds subject to juniors shooting appropriate round for their age group and dependent upon entries
Shooting control: Timed ends with audible signals.

Burntwood York - all arrows are shot at a target set at 30metres distance, starting with 6 dozen at a 60cm size face and progressing through to 4 dozen at a 80cm face and 2 dozen at a full 122cm face.

Rules of shooting

GNAS Rules of shooting will apply. To comply with record status of shoot all clothing worn on the shooting line must be National, GNAS (plain dark green and/or white) or registered club colours.

All archers will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or Guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers on the entry form.

A selection of hot and cold refreshments will be available throughout the day.

AWARDS

Awards will be given on the day for all GNAS bowstyles. Club teams will be compiled from Ladies and Gents shooting the appropriate senior round, irrespective of age.

Special awards will be given for all Major Rounds based on GNAS Classification Groups (Sussex).

No awards will be given for senior archers shooting junior rounds. Juniors shooting senior rounds will be eligible for senior awards if paying senior fee.
